

ZIMSTAT wishes to appreciate the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) for the in-depth analysis of the 2022 Population and Housing Census data initiative, as well as the technical and financial assistance that made it possible to develop the profiles. The profiles provide a very valuable source of information for evidence-based decision-making for government ministries, departments, agencies, local authorities, development partners, the donor community and the Zimbabwean population in general.



For each indicator, a district is placed into any of 5 groups or quintiles depending on how well it performs. Quintile 1 (Q1) represents the least performing group of districts, while the group of second least performing districts is placed in Q2. Districts that show an average performance are grouped into Q3 and so on. Districts that show top performance are glaced in Quintile 5 (Q5). Quintiles are color-coded and are shown alongside the rank in the indicator are color-coded and are shown alongside the rank in the indicator green provides a quick way of knowing how well a district performed in the census (see below). Where it is neither good nor bad to have higher/lower values (neutral indicators), a light blue to dark blue coloring is used to show intensity or magnitude.

z. Ranking

The secondary in-depth analysis of 2022 census data creates two composite indices namely, **Spatial Deprivation Index (SDI) and Progress Index (PI).** SDI summarizes selected indicators as at 2022 in one index. It is a multi-dimensional poverty index that combines key social indicators into a composite deprivation/poverty index to identify the most deprived areas and guide interventions. On the other hand, PI is a composite indicator that shows the progress made from 2012 to 2022. Information from the composite indicators may be used to facilitate geographical targeting to alleviate the situation of children, adolescents and women.




