Objectives of the Survey

The Quarterly Labour Force Survey aims to establish the following:

- a) Employment level
- b) Characteristics of employed persons
- c) Employment in the informal economy
- d) Income levels
- e) Labour migration
- f) Labour underutilisation

Summary of Survey Findings



Labour force participation rate refers to the proportion of the working age population that is in labour force

Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR) by Province and Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024


Labour force participation rate for Harare province was **63.1** percent.

For Bulawayo province, the LFPR was **62.9** percent



Quarterly Percentage Changes in Labour Force Participation Rates by Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024

The labour force participation rate decreased by **0.4** percentage points in the third quarter of 2024 compared to first quarter 2024.







Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR) by Rural/Urban Areas and Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024

Labour force participation rate for persons in urban areas was **62.8** percent while for persons in rural areas it was **38.2** percent.

In urban areas, the male labour force participation rate was **75.1** percent while for females the rate was **52.6** percent.



Employment to population ratio is the proportion of working age population that is in employment.


Employment to Population Ratio (EPR) by Province and Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024

Bulawayo province had an employment to population ratio of **44.8** percent and Harare province was at **49.6** percent.




Quarterly Percentage Changes in Employment to Population Ratio by Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024

The 2024 3rd quarter employment to population ratio decreased by **1.0** percentage points compared to the 1st quarter of 2024.



Employment to Population Ratio by Age Group and Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024


The age-group 36-45 had highest employment to population ratio for both Males (67.5%) and Females (42.8%).





Employment to Population Ratio (EPR) by Rural/Urban Areas and Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024


Employment to population ratio for persons in urban areas was **49.2** percent while for rural areas the ratio was **29.8** percent.

For females in rural areas, the employment to population ratio was **20.7** percent. For males in rural areas, the rate was **40.8** percent.















Distribution of Employed Population by Major Sector and Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024

The Informal sector comprised **58.3** percent of the employed population, and the Formal sector, **35.6** percent.


Of the employed females, **58.1** percent were in the Informal sector, while **58.3** percent of the employed males were also in the same sector.



Distribution of Employed Population by Sector and Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024.


The Informal sector (Non-Agriculture) comprised **43.6** percent of the employed population, and the Agriculture sector, **20.3** percent.

Of the employed females, **19.0** percent were in the Agriculture sector, while **21.1** percent of the employed males were also in the same sector.




Quarterly Percentage Changes in Employed Population by Major Sector of Employment and Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024

Employed population in Informal sector (non-agriculture) increased by 2.3 percentage points in the third quarter of 2024 compared to 1st quarter 2024.




Distribution of Employed Population by Province and Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024

Employed males in Harare province constituted **25.5** percent of all employed males, as **24.1** percent of all employed females was also in the same province.



Distribution of Employed Population by Major Contributing Industries to Employment, 3rd Quarter 2024


Most of the employed population (22.8%) were in the Wholesale and retail trade; sale and repair of motor vehicles and motor cycles.



Distribution of Employed Population by Occupation and Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024


Persons in **Elementary occupations** made up **27.2** percent of all employed persons.

Highest proportion of employed females (36.5%) was in Service and sales workers.




Distribution of Employed Persons with at Least One Form of Functional Disability by Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024

Of all employed persons, **0.7** percent had at least one form of functional disability.



Distribution of Employed Population by Hours of Work Per Week and Sex , 3rd Quarter 2024


Most of the male (724,713) and female (455,316) employed population, reported having 40 – 49 hours per week as usual working hours.




Distribution of Employees Persons by Income Band in ZWG, 3rd Quarter 2024

Of the employed persons, 21.9 percent had labour incomes between ZWG 2,501 and ZWG 5,000

NB: exchange rate at the time of survey was USD1:ZWG13.85

Employment in Informal Economy, 3rd Quarter 2024

Employment in informal economy comprises of persons employed in informal sector and informally employed persons.

Informal Sector constituted **58.3** percent of all employed persons.

Employed persons in the Informal Sector (Non-Agriculture) constituted 43.6 percent of all employed persons.

Informally employed persons were 85.5 percent of all employed persons.

Of all persons employed in non-agriculture sectors, informally employed persons constituted 83.1 percent.



Unemployment Rate by Province and Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024


Unemployment rate for Midlands province was **22.1** percent.

Female unemployment rate for the province was **24.0** percent while the male unemployment rate was **20.9** percent.




Quarterly Percentage Changes in Unemployment Rates, 3rd Quarter 2024

The 2024 3rd quarter unemployment rate increased by **1.2** percentage points compared to the 1st quarter of 2024.




Unemployment Rate for Persons with at least one Form of Functional Disability by Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024

The unemployment rate for persons with at least one form of functional disability was 22.1 percent.




Distribution of Discouraged Job Seekers by Age Group and Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024

Proportion of Employed Population in Time Related Underemployment by Industry, 3rd Quarter 2024



Proportions of youth not in education, employment or training (NEET) for the age group 15 – 24 years, was **44.3** percent in Bulawayo province and **44.8** percent in Masvingo province.



Proportion of Youth NEET (15-35 Years) by Province and Sex, 3rd Quarter 2024


For the 15-35 years age group, the youth NEET proportion was **56.3** percent for Mashonaland Central province.




Distribution of Employed Persons who Reported Work Related Illnesses/Injuries by Industry, 3rd Quarter 2024




Labour migrants, 3rd Quarter 2024
