External Trade Statistics: February 2025

Exports

The total value of exported goods in February 2025 was **USD 512.6** million, representing a **21.4%** decrease from **USD 652.0** million reported in January 2025.

Imports

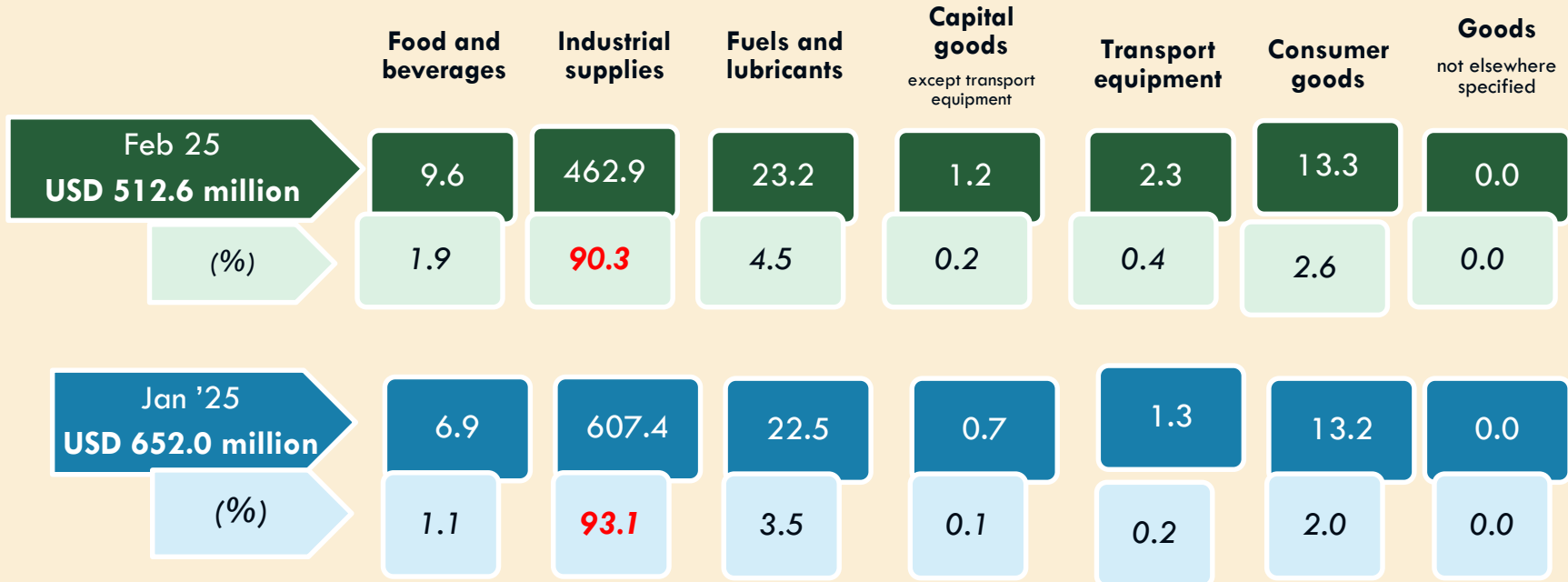
Imports for February 2025 amounted to **USD 730.3** million, a decrease of **2.5%** from **USD 749.2** million recorded in January 2025.

Trade Deficit

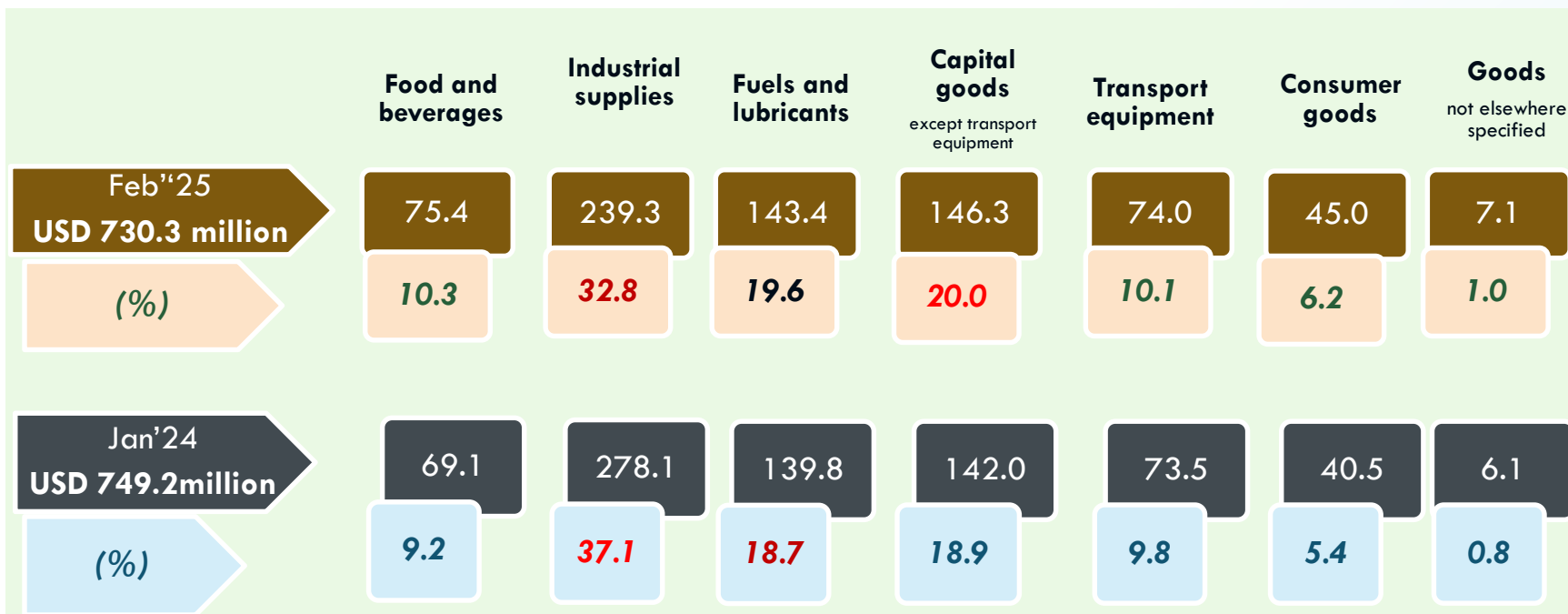
The February 2025 trade deficit for goods was **USD 217.7** million, translating to a **124.2% increase** from a deficit of **USD 97.1** million recorded in January 2025.

Exports Classified by Broad Economic Category (BEC)

Industrial supplies comprised **90.3%** of the goods exported in February 2025

32.8% of the goods imported in February 2025, comprised industrial supplies, followed by the capital goods category which accounted for **20%**

Among the top ten products exported in February 2025 were semi-manufactured gold (42.3%), Tobacco (15.8%) and nickel mattes (13.2%)

Mineral fuels (20.5%), Machinery & Mechanical Appliances (14.2%), Cereals (10.0%) and Vehicles (8.5%) were among the top ten products imported in the same month.

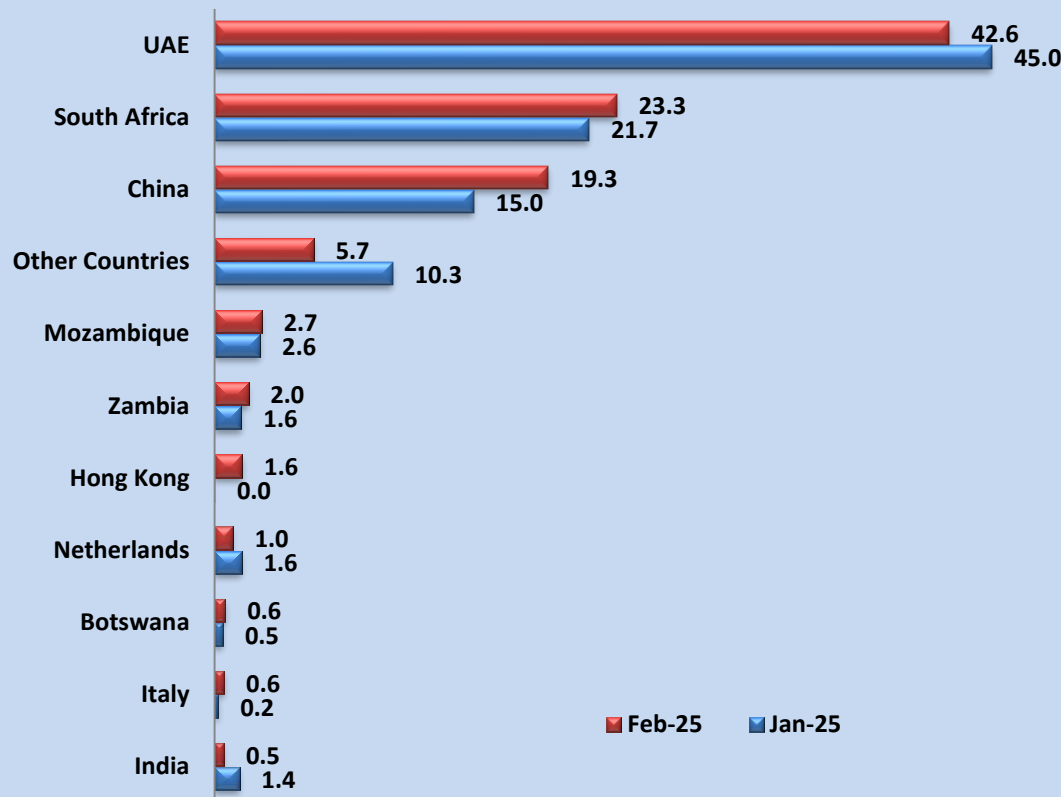

Feb 2025 exports value =USD 512.6 million

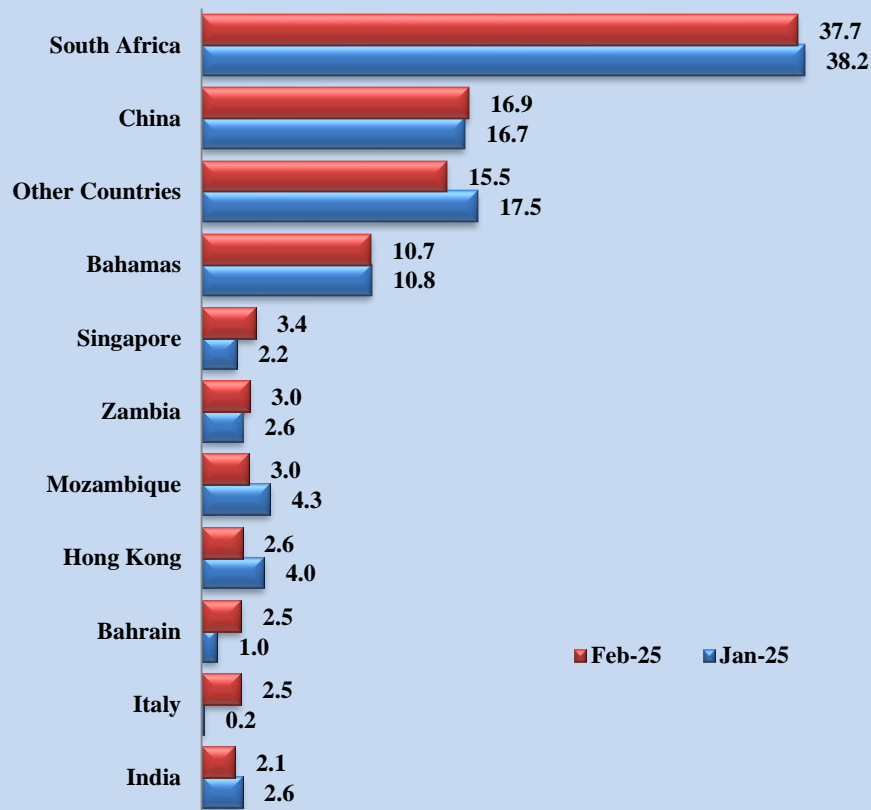
Jan' 2025 exports value=USD 652.0 million

Among the country's major export destinations in February 2025 were the United Arab Emirates (**42.6%**), South Africa (**23.3%**) and China (**19.3%**) .

The three countries accounted for around eighty five percent of the total export value of **USD 512.6 million**.

Among the major source countries for imports in February 2025 were South Africa (37.7%), China (16.9%), Bahamas (10.7%) and Singapore (3.4%)

The four countries accounted for around sixty nine percent of the total import value of **USD 730.3 million**.

The Weighted Inflation Rate

Month-on-Month Inflation Rate

The Weighted month-on-month inflation rate was **0.0** percent in March 2025, shedding 0.3 percentage points on the February 2025 rate of **0.3** percent.

The month-on-month inflation rate is given by the percentage change in the price index of the reference month compared with the price index of the previous month.

The USD Inflation Rate

Month-on-Month Inflation Rate

The USD month-on-month inflation rate was **0.1** percent in March 2025, shedding 0.1 percentage points on the February 2025 rate of **0.2** percent.

The month-on-month inflation rate is given by the percentage change in the price index of the reference month compared with the index of the previous month.

Year-on-Year Inflation Rate

The USD year-on-year inflation rate (annual percentage change) for the month of March 2025 as measured by the all-items USD Consumer Price Index (CPI), was **15.0** percent.

The year-on-year inflation rate is given by the percentage change in the price index of the reference month of a given year, compared with the price index of the same month in the previous year.

For the month of March 2025, the USD CPI for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages contributed mostly to the month-on-month change in index (inflation rate) by a magnitude of 0.07 %.

The ZWG Inflation Rate

Month-on-Month Inflation Rate

The ZWG month-on-month inflation rate was **-0.1** percent in March 2025, shedding -0.6 percentage points on the February 2025 rate of **0.5** percent.

The month-on-month inflation rate is given by the percentage change in the price index of the reference month compared with the index of the previous month.

For the month of March 2025, the ZWG CPI for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages contributed mostly to the month-on-month change in index (inflation rate) by a magnitude of -0.2%.

ZWG 864.20

The Food Poverty Line (FPL) for one person in March 2025 was **ZWG 864.20**.

Food Poverty Line represents the amount of money that an individual requires to afford a daily minimum energy intake of 2,100 calories.

ZIMSTAT uses the consumer basket for an individual deemed to be extremely poor to calculate the poverty line.

The Total Consumption Poverty Line (TCPL) for one person was **ZWG 1,260.52** in March 2025.

The Total Consumption Poverty Line is derived by adding the non-food consumption expenditures of an individual deemed to be extremely poor and the FPL.

The month-on-month rate of change in February 2025 was **0.6** percent, shedding 1.8 percentage points on the January 2025 rate of **2.4** percent.
