Vehicles Registered for the First Time

During the 2nd quarter 2024, the total number of vehicles registered for the first time decreased by **35.0%**, from **24,428** recorded in 1st quarter 2024 to **15,890**.




The number of light motor vehicles registered for the first time decreased by **33.7%** from **18,539** recorded during 1st quarter 2024 to **12,296**.




Road Traffic Accidents

Road traffic accidents increased by **9.6%**, from **13,026** that occurred in 1st quarter 2024 to **14,280**.



Road Traffic Accidents



The **14,280** road traffic accidents that were reported during 2nd quarter 2024 resulted in **594** deaths and **2,783** injuries.

Certificate of competence tests


About of **fifty percent** of the **55,136** candidates who underwent certificate of competence tests during 2nd quarter 2024 succeeded.

Proportions of candidates who passed certificate of competence tests during 2nd quarter 2024, were less than fifty percent in all provinces except Harare and Mash East, which recorded 55.9% and 59.3% respectively.



Flights by Airport




- All airports reported more flights (military flights excluded) in 2nd quarter

Air Passengers by Airport




All airports, recorded an increase in the number of passengers during 2nd quarter 2024 when compared to 1st quarter 2024.

Inland Water Transport



The number of Inland water vessels registered for the first time during 2nd quarter 2024 was **34**, showing a **38.2 percent** decrease from **55** in 1st quarter 2024.

Railway Transport: Volume of goods transported (tonnes)



During 2nd quarter 2024, the volume of goods transported through rail was **449,040** net tonnes, reflecting a **44.5**% percent increase from **310,702** net tonnes recorded in 1st quarter 2024.
